- Use towels instead of paper towels to clean up messes.



THINGS YOU CAN DO IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD

- Use a refillable water bottle.
- Ask your parents about re-usable bags for shopping instead of using plastic bags.
- Take fewer napkins when you're at a restaurant, and choose to not use a straw.
- Talk to your parents about donating old toys or clothes.
- If you have a snack or drink outside, take all of your garbage with you. Recycle what you can, and make sure the rest makes it into a garbage can.
