## **POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT: Invasive Species Technician**

**Employer:** Genesee Conservation District (GCD)

**Work Location:** Based out of Genesee Conservation District in Flint, MI. Position covers Genesee, Lapeer, Livingston, and Shiawassee counties.

### **Position Summary**

The Genesee, Lapeer, Livingston, and Shiawassee Cooperative Invasive Species Management Area (GiLLS CISMA) is a collaborative that provides surveying, monitoring, technical assistance, and outreach for invasive species concerns. This is a part-time, grant-funded position. Actual hours per week will vary according to workload and are expected to average around 20 hours per week, with potential to increase to 40 hours per week, contingent on funding. The schedule for this job is primarily 8am - 4:30pm, but may include some evenings, and weekends, as needed. The technician will working under the direction of the GiLLS CISMA Coordinator and Genesee Conservation District Administrator.

The technician will conduct field work surveying and monitoring invasive species, with an emphasis on stiltgrass (*Microstegium vimineum*), red swamp crayfish (*Procambarus clarkii*), and other priority species listed on our strategic plan throughout our service area. There will also be chances to interact and assist with public outreach events, social media, as well as other CISMA functions that aid in deliverables throughout the four-county area.

### **Qualifications**

- College experience in biology or environmental science
- General knowledge of invasive species problems and identification
- Comfortable working outside in field conditions with exposure to variable weather conditions, temperatures, and insects
- Comfortable working in/on water (wading/kayaking) and able to walk up to 3 miles/day on land
- Invasive species identification and survey protocol training will be provided, but experience identifying invasive species and Michigan's native species is a plus
- GIS/mapping experience preferred
- A valid Michigan driver's license and reliable transportation

### **Compensation**

Pay rate will be \$16/\$17 per hour. This is a part-time position that will occur between May and September 2026.
